Legal Notice Request for Bids – Snow Plowing

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sandwich Community Fire Protection District is seeking bids for the 2018-2019 winter season:

Sealed bids, subject to all instructions, terms and conditions herein and pursuant to the specifications, will be received by the Board of Trustees of the Sandwich Community Fire Protection District at the Office of said District located at 310 East Railroad Street, Sandwich, Illinois 60548, until 7:00 p.m. on November 8, 2018, where they will be opened publicly and read aloud after 7:00 p.m. on the said date, for the service as specified and the contract awarded as soon thereafter as practical for:

Snow Plowing Service, including the following tasks to be performed per event:

- 1) Plow all parking areas.
- 2) Salt all parking areas.
- 3) Shovel/snow blow all sidewalks.
- 4) Ice Melt all sidewalks. NOTE – sidewalks need to be salted with care to avoid salting adjacent landscaping.
- 5) The contractor will accept any and all responsibility for damage to lawn and or landscaping due to plowing or salting and will correct as necessary in a timely manner.

These tasks will be required at 1 or more inches accumulation or upon request from the Fire Chief.

Payment will be made monthly per invoices received.

Interested bidders will be requested to submit their bid in a sealed envelope marked with the words "2018-2019 Snow Plowing Service". The actual bid must be in writing using the Snow Plow Service 2018-2019 form which can be found on our website at sandwichfd.com. This form can also be picked up in person at the fire station. A certificate of liability insurance must also accompany the bid for the bid to be considered.

The Sandwich Community Fire Protection District reserves the right to award this contract or to reject all of the bids submitted or any part of any bid submitted if it determines, at the discretion of the Board of Trustees, that to do so is in the best interests of the District.
